

**TRANSPORT EMERGENCY CARD (ROAD)**

CLASS 3 - FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS

LOAD

Vinylacetat monomer [Vinyl acetate, inhibited]

LOAD CHARACTERISTICS

- * Liquid

NATURE OF HAZARD

- * Highly flammable (flashpoint less than +23 degrees celsius)
- * Leaking liquid evaporates - risk of explosion
- * Vapours may be narcotic, high concentration may lead to unconsciousness
- * May decompose in a fire giving off toxic fumes. The effect of inhalation may be delayed
- * May form explosive mixtures with air, particularly in empty uncleaned receptacles
- * Heating will cause pressure rise - with risk of bursting and explosion
- * Possible hazards to surface waters and purification plants

PERSONAL PROTECTION

Warning vest or warning clothing for every member of the vehicle crew
A hand lamp for every member of the vehicle crew
Suitable protective gloves, -boots and protective clothing
Goggles giving complete protection to the eyes
Eye-wash bottle with clean water

GENERAL ACTIONS BY THE DRIVER

Stop the engine
No naked lights, no smoking
Mark roads and warn other users or passers-by
Inform the public about the hazard and give advice to keep upwind
Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible

ADDITIONAL AND / OR SPECIAL ACTION BY THE DRIVER**MIND YOUR SELF-PROTECTION**

- * Seal leaks if this can be realized without incurring risks
- * Prevent the liquid entering sewers, workpits and basements
- * Absorb leaking liquid with earth or similar material
- * Remove or make safe all sources of ignition
- * Warn everybody - explosion hazard
- * If substance has entered a water course or sewer or contaminated soil or vegetation advise fire brigade or police

FIRE , INFORMATION FOR THE DRIVER IN CASE OF FIRE

Use fire extinguishers only for smaller fires in connection with the vehicle
Do not fight fires involving load
Leave greater fires to the care of the fire department

FIRST AID

- * If substance has got into the eyes, immediately wash out with plenty of water for several minutes, send to a doctor
- * Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected skin with soap and water
- * In case of burns immediately cool affected skin as long as possible with cold water
- * Seek medical attention when anyone has symptoms apparently due to inhalation, swallowing or contact with the skin or eyes or following inhalation of the fumes produced in a fire
